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Kentucky Science Center gets national recognition

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The Kentucky Science Center has been gaining attention nationwide.

The Louisville museum has been voted as one of the top 10 children's museums in the U.S. by Tripping.com, a vacation rental search engine.

The Kentucky Science Center ranks No. 5 on the list, behind the Please Touch Museum in Philadelphia, the Children's Museum of Indianapolis, Port Discovery Children's Museum in Baltimore and Montshire Museum in Vermont.

Tripping.com notes the Louisville museum's new "Science in Play" exhibit, where children can learn and explore at the same time. The site also points out that the museum's offerings aren't just for kids — the four-story theater attracts visitors of all ages and speaker series and date-night specials draw adults.

The Kentucky Science Center is at 727 W. Main St.

Other museums that made the list are the Glazer Children's Museum in Tampa Bay, Fla.; The DoSeum in San Antonio; the Santa Fe Children's Museum in New Mexico; the Madison Children's Museum in Wisconsin; and the Children's Discovery Museum of San Jose in California.
